Overview



as response to the SRP Secretariat's request for organizations interested to establish an official SRP training programme and identify authorized training service providers

- Inconsistent understanding of SRP instrument & tool application in varied contexts and by different audiences
- Stakeholders have independently developed and delivered SRP-related training, however typically project-specific and geared to narrow audiences
- From the SRP training Workshop, May'17 –organised by IRRI and SRP Secretariat, the participants (SRP members) have noted & recognised:
 - the need to have a common understanding of the SRP instrument & tool, to facilitate consistent and quality implementation and credible claims
 - the need to compile the best practices as a centralized training package which will help the producers to improve towards sustainability

Suggestion to SRP:





- Develop authorized training packages for SRP implementation
- Establish an authorized training delivery system
 - Authorized institutions & trainers
 - Only deliver by persons that have completed SRP authorized training curricula in SRP outreach programs



SRP AC/IB and SRP Secretariat approve GIZ voluntary proposal, as the following:

- GIZ leads the facilitation of the Training Task Force
- Training Task Force develops the training delivery system
- AIZ as an authorized SRP training provider to deliver trainings and give input for didactive approach of the trainings
- Task Force & AIZ to develop training income stream for SRP with estimated at 25% of total training fees

To provide the training system & the modules to SRP members by end of 2019

The results will be assessed after one year (end 2019) to determine further steps

Training – TASK FORCE





- Role of the Task Force : develop, design, test training materials
 Role, and the set-up will be revisited in end of 2019
- Lead agencies: GIZ*, IRRI, and Rikolto
- **Member criteria**: < 5members: open for recruitment until Feb'19
 - Be a member of the SRP for at least 2 years
 - Has conducted / technically engaged in the SRP standard v1.0 & Performance Indicator pilot testing for at least 2 rice crop cycle
 - Have a track record of at least five (5) years in providing public or customized training activities
